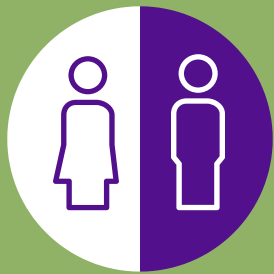
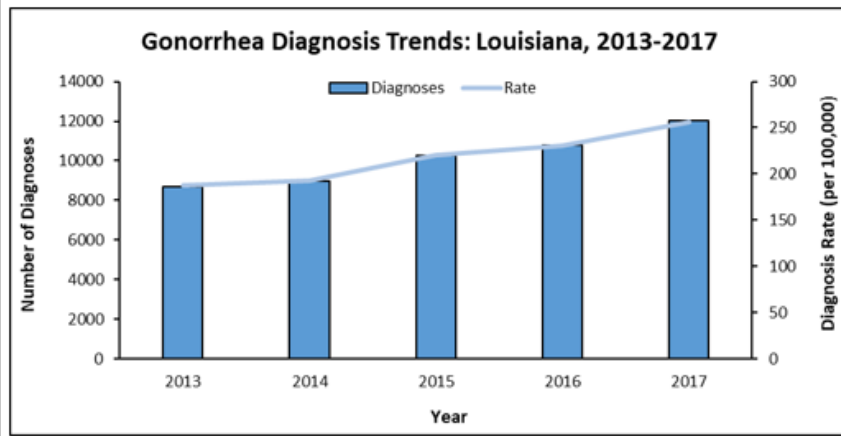
Louisiana

Gonorrhea diagnoses in the United States have **increased 67%** since 2013



In 2017, **Louisiana ranked 3rd** in the nation for gonorrhea diagnosis rates

12,017 people were diagnosed with gonorrhea in Louisiana in 2017



Men account for **half** of all gonorrhea diagnoses in Louisiana, a 17% increase from 2013.

Gonorrhea Diagnoses by Age

Over half

of gonorrhea diagnoses were among persons 15-24 years old



Under 14 (1%) 15-19 (23%) 20-24 (34%) 25-35 (29%) 35+ (13%)

Gonorrhea Diagnoses by Race



76% of gonorrhea diagnoses were among Blacks, but **only 32%** of Louisiana's population is Black
