

LA DRUG ASSISTANCE PROGRAM COORD

The Louisiana Drug Assistance Program (LDAP) Coordinator will assist the STD/HIV/Hepatitis Program (SHHP) of the Office of Public Health (OPH) in maintaining and monitoring the Louisiana Drug Assistance Program (LDAP) within the Louisiana Health Access Program (LA HAP). The incumbent will oversee the provision of essential services to increase access to HIV medications for eligible low income Louisiana residents living with HIV infection. The Coordinator will be responsible for the implementation and monitoring of all LDAP activities and the assurance that the program meets all State and federal regulations. This includes the verification that all relevant Conditions of Award are met during the provision of essential health services to approximately 6000 unduplicated clients, as well as assurance of compliance with all programmatic requirements from the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA).
