PBM Contract and Medications Coordinator: Southeast LA Area Health Education Center (SELA AHEC), in conjunction with the Louisiana Office of Public Health-STD/HIV Program (OPH-SHHP), are seeking a Pharmacy Benefit Manager (PBM) Contract and Medications Coordinator. The position is integral to the administration and sustainability of the Louisiana Health Access Program (LA HAP) a complex statewide program tasked with providing medications for HIV and related opportunistic infections, and assisting with the costs of insurance coverage for eligible individuals living with HIV. The incumbent will oversee the provision of essential services to increase access to HIV and other essential medications for eligible low income Louisiana residents living with HIV infection. The Coordinator will be responsible for the implementation and monitoring of all medication assistance activities and the assurance that the program meets all State and federal regulations. Required: Bachelor's in Health Care Administration or Finance, Pharmacy Services, Public Health, Social Work, Public Administration or closely related field; Three (3) years of professional level experience. Eligible candidates must have a general knowledge of the transmission of communicable diseases and social determinants of health as they relate to and impact health outcomes. Preferred: Master's in Public Health, Public Administration, Healthcare Management, Psychology, Sociology or related field; Five (5) years of related professional experience, including a strong knowledge of HIV care and services; In addition to the above, knowledge of resources and services available to low income persons, and/or is able to research and identify new or emerging resources for this population. Excellent verbal and written communication skills and highly competent in ability to collaborate with diverse colleagues and individuals.
