As a Team Leader, s/he/they will be responsible for linking/retaining vulnerable populations into medical and supportive services, while assisting and supporting clients in overcoming barriers to care; will be responsible for oversight of day to day operations of the team and directly oversee Linkage to Care activities. Will be expected to maintain interactions with clients as well as work a small case load, while managing supervisory duties that include but are not limited to: participate in departmental meetings, contribute to writing grants and monthly reports, oversee data, community/provider engagement, and other duties to support clients living with HIV and HIV/HCV co-infections..

Excellent skills in community engagement, facilitation, quality assurance and policy and procedural development. General knowledge of Hepatitis C and/or STIs, case management, transmission, treatment adherence, health education and risk reduction.

Required: Bachelor's degree in a social science or human related field, at least four years of experience in community engagement with vulnerable populations, and at least two years of supervisory experience.

Preferred: Master's degree, three years of experience in community engagement with vulnerable populations, and three years of supervisory experience.
