Acadiana CARES, in conjunction with the Louisiana Office of Public Health Tuberculosis (TB) Control Program is currently recruiting an individual to serve as Disease Intervention Specialist (DIS) in the Office of Public Health Tuberculosis Control Program's Wetmore TB Clinic, located in New Orleans, Louisiana. This position supports the program's efforts to decrease the TB-related morbidity and mortality in Louisiana through surveillance, data quality assurance, case management, disease investigation and other administrative responsibilities.

A successful candidate must have excellent communication and interpersonal skills, strong time management, and experience with patient care, social work, or other related field. A Bachelor's degree in any field is required. Preferred candidates will possess a degree in public health, biological science, epidemiology, health sciences, social work or other similar field of study. Special consideration given to candidates who are fluent in Spanish or Vietnamese language.
