


As part of the Big Bet, **17,845** persons

**14,971** persons have started treatment for HCV through Medicaid for the first time


**13,405** persons who have accessed treatment have completed it

**10,950** persons have accessed treatment because of Medicaid Expansion


**1,066** providers have written prescriptions for DAAs for the first time

**675** persons who did not complete treatment and whose last HCV RNA was positive


# People Treated in Medicaid by Treatment Completion and Monitoring of SVR, 7/15/2019-9/30/2024






People Treated in Medicaid by Treatment Completion, and SVR by Birth Sex,  
7/15/2019-9/30/2024




Results of SVR for People Treated for HCV in Medicaid by Birth Sex,  
7/15/2019-9/30/2024




People Treated in Medicaid by Treatment Completion, and SVR by Race/Ethnicity,  
7/15/2019-9/30/2024




Results of SVR for People Treated for HCV in Medicaid by Race/Ethnicity,  
7/15/2019-9/30/2024




### People Treated in Medicaid by Treatment Completion, and SVR by Age Group, 7/15/2019-9/30/2024




Results of SVR for People Treated for HCV in Medicaid by Age Group,  
7/15/2019-9/30/2024




### People Treated in Medicaid by Treatment Completion, and SVR by Region, 7/15/2019-9/30/2024




Results of SVR for People Treated for HCV in Medicaid by Region,
